The goal of the Housing and Human Services Grant (HHSG) program is to meet the needs of low and moderate income resident and to provide a more desirable living environment for all residents within the City. The HHSG Program is comprised of the following funding sources:

Community Development Block Grant Program, also known as CDBG, is a program of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which provides federal grant funds to the City of Livermore. Over the past 20 years CDBG has been supporting various non-profit organizations and agencies serving lower income Livermore residents. This program now also includes **Neighborhood Stabilization Program** funding received through the State of California.

HOME Investment Partnership Program funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) are received through the Alameda County HOME Consortium. The goal of the HOME Program is to expand and preserve the supply of affordable housing for lower income households by building new or rehabilitating existing affordable housing.
