APPEALS: FINAL DECISIONS OF THE COMMISSION FOR THE ARTS MAY BE APPEALED TO THE CITY COUNCIL BY ANY INTERESTED PARTY. APPEALS MUST BE FILED WITH THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT WITHIN 14 DAYS OF THE COMMISSION FOR THE ART'S DECISION. THE FILING FEE FOR SUCH APPEALS RANGE FROM \$304.00 TO \$368.00.
